## You Said, We Did!

### Spring 2019

Working Together Team want to ensure our service is continually working within best practice and meeting the needs of our settings, families and young people.

#### You Said:

During year 2018-2019 you told us that you would like training to be accessible more locally.

#### We Did:

Training offer enhanced to include Grantham and Spalding and to sit alongside the Lincoln and Gosberton offers. East of the county offer currently being planned.

#### You Said:

Families with Autistic children tell us that there is very little support for them once their children leave primary school .

#### We Did:

WTT trained 6 staff as licensed facilitators for the NAS Teen Life Programme. Courses are taking place this year in the East Lindsey area, Spalding and Grantham.

#### You Said:

Staff in schools tell us that they can feel stuck in their practice due to school systems and policies which are inflexible for individual needs.

#### We Did:

From September 2018 WTT are offering 2 FREE places on our Autism Education Trust Leading Good Autism Practice training to Senior leaders or Governors from each of our Lincolnshire maintained schools/academies.

#### You Said:

In Autumn 2018 SENCOs reported to us that the report template was frustrating to read due to the layout of the target boxes.

#### We Did:

For Jan 2019 the report template was updated and reorganised to make this easier to read and take up less paper.
