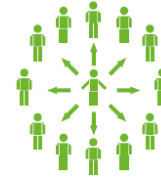

Good Autism Practice

Complex Needs and Participation

Specialist services

Focusing on training for staff in specialist settings who support school-age pupils on the autism spectrum who have complex needs. It aims to deepen participants' understanding of autism in ways in which they can support pupil participation, including development of their personal EHC Plans.
